Value of Scholarship \$2500 payable in 2 equal portions in December and the

following February of the academic year for which the award is made. In order to receive the second installment, the recipient must provide an official communication from their institution confirming successful completion of the

fall semester.

Eligibility This scholarship is open to any CIM National member or

to maintenance and reliability issues in the mining

industry.
